### What is Fiber Optics?

Fiber optics is a way of sending information through thin fibers, or threads. The information may be sound, pictures, or computer codes. This information travels through the fibers in the form of light.

Optical fiber is tiny, about the diameter of a strand of human hair. It's made of silica (glass), chosen for its ability to reflect in a way that allows the light to transmit data efficiently. It's made up of a core, through which the light travels, cladding, which prevents the light from escaping, and a coating, which protects the fiber from damage and moisture. A single-mode fiber has a small core and can carry data longer distances, due to its ability to transmit a single laser.

### **Did You Know?**

Fiber = Bandwidth. Fiber has an incredibly high bandwidth capacity.
Fiber = Less outside Interference. Fiber is immune to interferences.
Fiber = Low Latency. Latency is the time it takes for a signal to travel to its destination.
Fiber = High Reliability. Poor weather conditions are not an issue for Fiber.
Fiber = Increased Speed. Fiber travels at about 70% of the speed of light.
Fiber = Long Lifespan. Once in place, has an estimated lifetime of 25 years or more.

# PEEPSIE TREATS

#### Directions

- In a medium, microwave-safe bowl, combine 2 1/3 cup Rice Krispies, 12 Peeps of one color, and 1 1/2 tablespoons butter, then microwave until Peeps expand and butter is melted, 40 seconds. Using a spatula or greased hands, combine until fully mixed.
- Spread Peepsie mixture into baking dish, then press to flatten. Repeat with remaining colors.
- Refrigerate until solid, 15 minutes, then slice and serve.
