- 7 In Ireland they used turnips and potatoes
- 8 Pumpkin seeds have a long history of nutritional use and natural remedy
- 9 It is actually considered a fruit because it starts from a flower
- 10 Six of the seven continents can grow pumpkins
- 11 Every part is edible, including the skin, leaves, flowers, and stem
- 12 It is a blend of cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg, and allspice and does not actually contain pumpkin
- 13 For many, many years Illinois maintains its leading position in pumpkin acreage
